Bardiya Nature Lodge (BNL) offers a rare escape into Nepal’s untouched wilderness. It is tucked away beside the gentle flow of the Aurahi River and the pristine edge of the Khata Migration Corridor.

Far from crowds and noise, this is a place where mornings begin with birdsong, days unfold in nature’s rhythm, and nights are wrapped in the quiet stillness of the forest.

Located just 8 kilometers from Bardiya National Park, the lodge enjoys easy access to one of Nepal’s finest wildlife destinations. The journey to the park is a scenic drive through traditional Tharu villages.

Attuwa Tower House

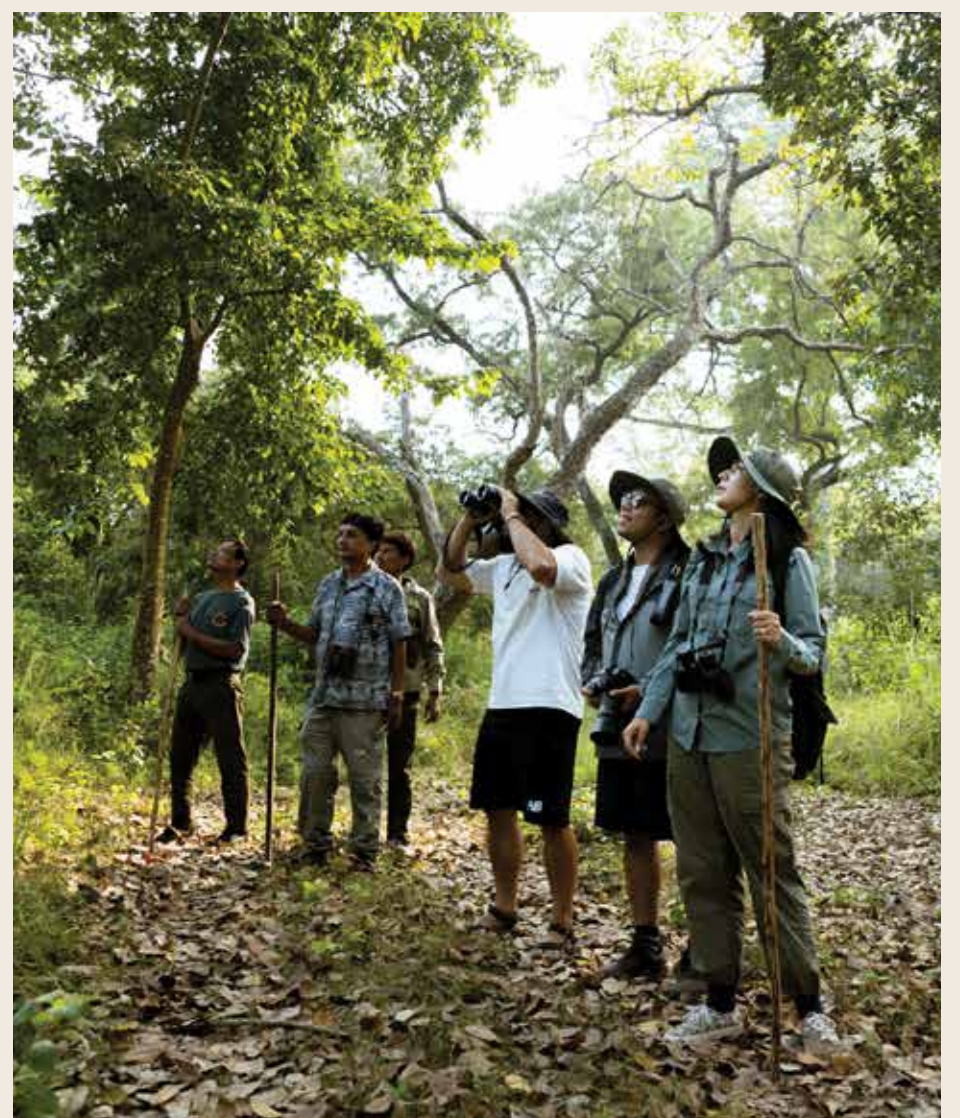
An elevated sanctuary offering luxury and an exclusive vantage point over the river and Khata forest.

Unwind under a starlit sky, far from city lights. A serene experience of silence and cosmic wonder.

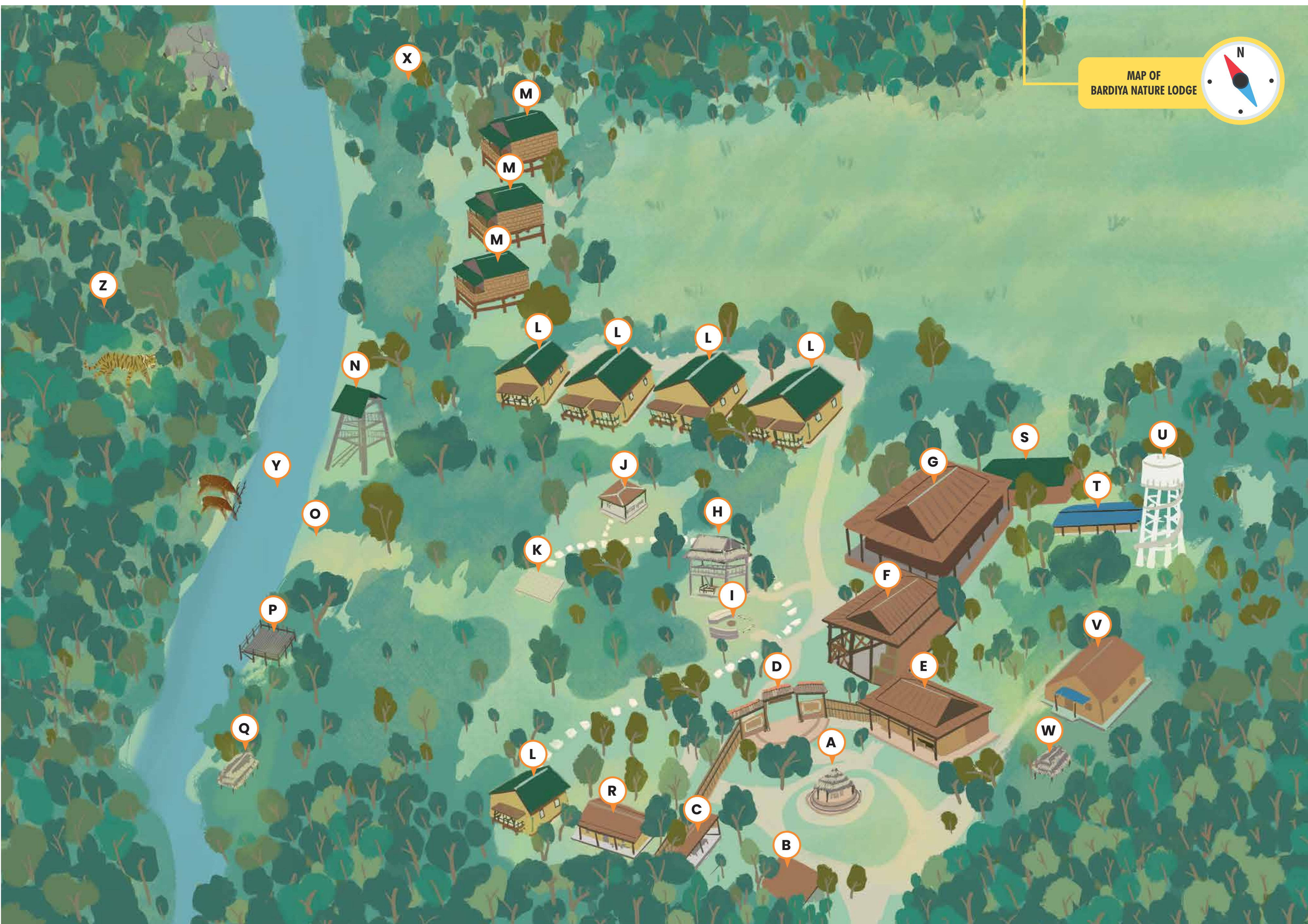

By Flight:

Flight from KTM to Nepalgunj. Approximately 1.5 hours drive from Nepalgunj Airport to Gulariya to BNL. (Airport pickup service available upon request)

By Bus:

KTM - Nepalgunj Buspark - Gulariya - BNL

By Private Vehicle:

Route 1: KTM - Bharatpur - Kapilvastu - Nepalgunj - Gulariya - BNL

Route 2: KTM - Bharatpur - Kohalpur - Bhurigaun - Belawa Chowk - Orali Bazaar - BNL (Longer route, but scenic through the National Park area)
